

Mining's Footprint in British Columbia

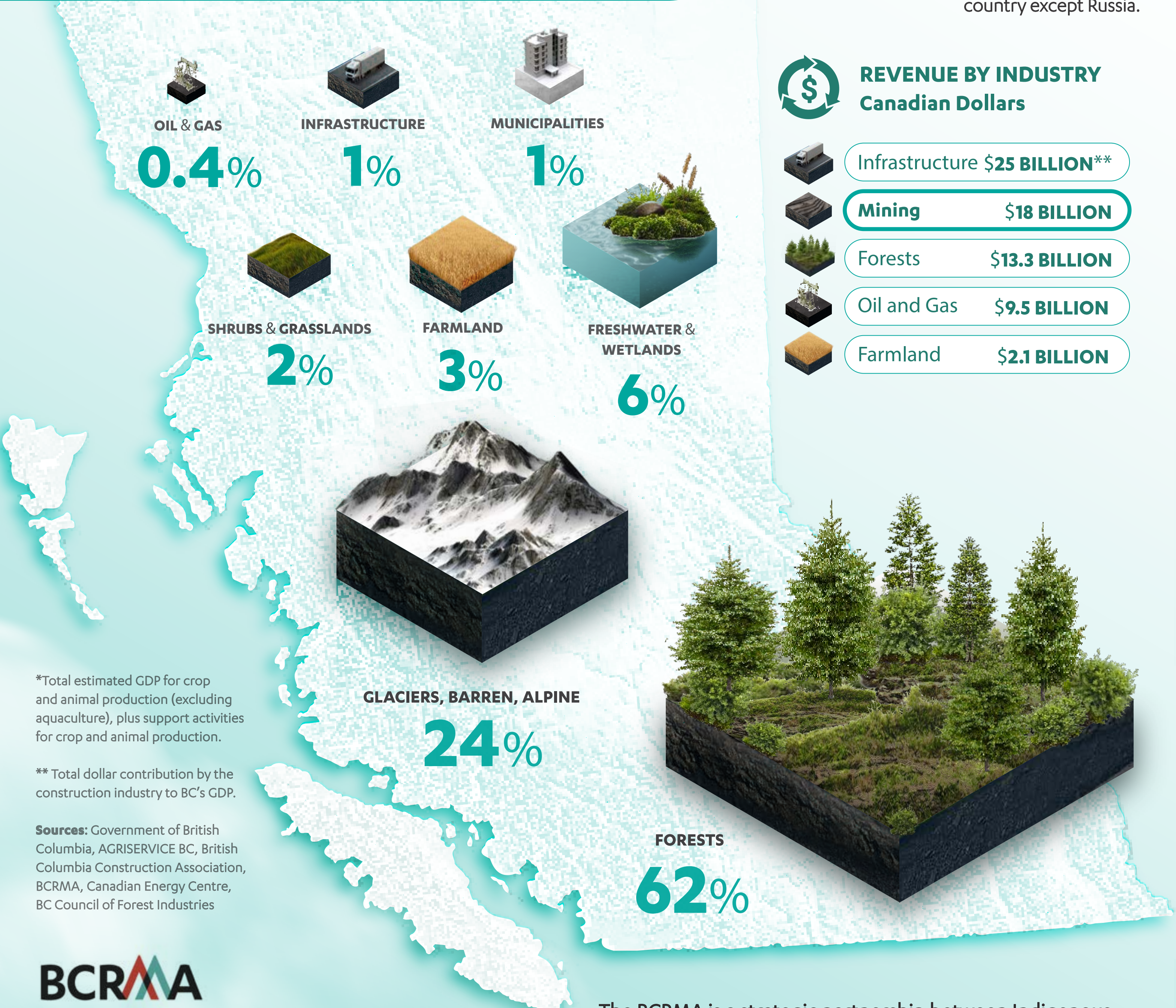
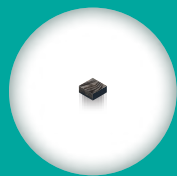
Canada's British Columbia (BC) is a global leader in the development of **socially and environmentally responsible resources**.

Over **54% of the province's total land is protected**, making it one of the world's greenest mining hubs.

BC covers almost **95 million hectares (234 million acres)**, more than any European country except Russia.

Mining only accounts for **0.04% of land use** in BC but represents **7% of the province's Gross Domestic Product (GDP)**.

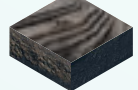

REVENUE BY INDUSTRY Canadian Dollars



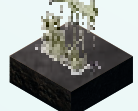

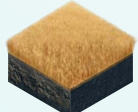
Mining **\$18 BILLION**
